## PASSING SIGNALS AT STOP

The Glenbrook rail accident has high lighted the need for rail personne to be aware of their responsibilities and obligations to strictly adhere to the existing procedures covering passing signals at stop.

It is imperative that train operations involving signals which are in operative, or not functioning normally, are strictly controlled at all times In particular, personnel should ensure that trains proceeding past a signal at stop can be brought to a stand prior to any obstruction or unsafe condition.

The co-operation of all rail personnel with the McInerney Inquiry into the Glenbrook accident is essential to minimising the potential for the recurrence of this type of accident.

The safety of all rail operations within New South Wales is an absolute priority at all times.
